### A Prophet Without Honor

6 Jesus left there and went to His hometown. His disciples followed Him. <sup>2</sup> When the Sabbath came, He began to teach in the synagogue. Many who heard Him were amazed. They asked, "Where did this man learn these things? What is this wisdom that has been given to this man? How is it that miracles such as these are performed by His hands?

<sup>3</sup> Isn't this the carpenter, the son of Mary and the brother of James, Joses, Judas, and Simon? And aren't His sisters here with us?" And they took offense at Him. <sup>4</sup> Jesus said to them, "A prophet is not without honor except in His hometown and among His own relatives and in His own house." <sup>5</sup> He could not do any miracles there except to lay His hands on a few sick people and heal them. <sup>6</sup> He was amazed at their unbelief. Then He went around the villages teaching.

#### **Jesus Sends Out the Twelve**

<sup>7</sup> Jesus called the Twelve and began to send them out two by two. He gave them authority over the unclean spirits. <sup>8</sup> He instructed them to take nothing for their journey except a staff—no bread, no bag, no money in their money belts. <sup>9</sup> They were to put on sandals but not to wear two coats. <sup>10</sup> He said to them, "Wherever you enter a house, stay there until you leave that area. <sup>11</sup> Any place that will not receive you or listen to you, as you leave there, shake off the dust that is under your feet as a testimony against them." <sup>12</sup> They went out and preached that people should repent. <sup>13</sup> They also drove out many demons. They anointed many sick people with oil and healed them.
