Jesus Walks on Water

⁴⁵ Immediately Jesus made his disciples get into the boat and go

ahead to the other side, to Bethsaida, while He Himself dismissed

the crowd. ⁴⁶ After He had sent them off, He went up the mountain

to pray. ⁴⁷ When it was evening, the boat was in the middle of the

sea, and Jesus was alone on the land.

⁴⁸ He saw them straining at the oars, because the wind was against them. About the fourth watch of the night, He went to them, walking on the sea. He was ready to pass by them. ⁴⁹ When they saw Him walking on the sea, they thought He was a ghost, and they cried out. ⁵⁰ They all saw Him and were terrified. Immediately He spoke with them and said, “Take courage! I am. Do not be afraid.” ⁵¹ Then He climbed up into the boat with them, and the wind stopped. They were completely amazed, ⁵² because they had not understood about the loaves. Instead, their hearts were hardened.

⁵³ When they had crossed over, they landed at Gennesaret and anchored there. ⁵⁴ As soon as they stepped out of the boat, people recognized Jesus. ⁵⁵ They ran around that whole region and began to bring sick people on their stretchers to where they heard He was. ⁵⁶ Wherever He entered villages, cities, or the countryside, they were laying sick people in the marketplaces and pleading with Him that they might just touch the edge of His garment. And all who touched Him were made well.
