

Gospel Reading Mark 7:24-37 EHV

The Faith of a Gentile Woman

²⁴ Jesus got up and went from there to the region of Tyre and Sidon. He entered a house and did not want anyone to know it, but He could not remain hidden. ²⁵ Instead, when a woman whose little daughter had an unclean spirit heard about Him, she immediately came and fell down at His feet. ²⁶ This woman was a Greek, of Syro-Phoenician origin. She asked Him to drive the demon out of her daughter. ²⁷ Jesus said to her, "Let the children be fed first, because it is not good to take the children's bread and throw it to their little dogs." ²⁸ "Lord," she answered, "their little dogs under the table also eat some of the children's crumbs." ²⁹ Then He said to her, "Because of this statement, go! The demon has gone out of your daughter." ³⁰ She went home, found the child lying on the bed and the demon gone. ³¹ Jesus left the region of Tyre again and went through Sidon to the Sea of Galilee, within the region of the Decapolis.

"Ephphatha! Be Opened!"

³² They brought a man to Him who was deaf and had a speech impediment. They pleaded with Jesus to place His hand on him. ³³ Jesus took him aside in private, away from the crowd. He put His fingers into the man's ears. Then He spit and touched the man's tongue. ³⁴ After He looked up to heaven, He sighed and said, *"Ephphatha!"* (which means "Be opened!") ³⁵ Immediately the man's ears were opened, His tongue was set free, and He began to speak plainly. ³⁶ Jesus gave the people strict orders to tell no one, but the more He did so, the more they kept proclaiming it. ³⁷ They were amazed beyond measure and said, "He has done everything well. He even makes the deaf hear and the mute speak!"
