8 In those days, there was another large crowd with nothing to eat, and *Jesus* called the disciples. He said to them, ²“I have compassion for the crowd, because they’ve stayed with Me for three days now and have nothing to eat. ³If I send them home hungry they’ll pass out on the way, for some of them have come from very far away.” ⁴His disciples answered Him, “How can anyone satisfy these people with bread here in a wasteland?”

⁵“How many loaves do you have?” *Jesus* was asking them. “Seven,” they said. ⁶He directed the crowd to recline on the ground. After taking the seven loaves and giving thanks, He broke them and began giving them to His disciples to serve; and they served them to the crowd. ⁷They also had a few small fish and, after offering a *blessing* for them, He commanded these to be served as well. ⁸They ate and were satisfied, and they picked up the broken pieces left over—seven baskets. ⁹About four thousand were there, and *Jesus* sent them away. ¹⁰Right away, He got into the boat with His disciples and went to the area of Dalmanutha.

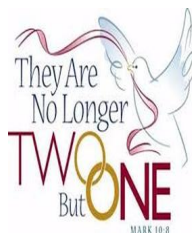
